TERRES d'IMAGINAIRE

LOCALITY: FRANCE – Loire – Anjou

APPELLATION: Vin de France

GRAPE VARIETY: Grolleau Noir

WINEMAKER: Mathilde Magne

VINEYARD: A small plot planted in the 2000s over clay soil with schist, sandstone, quartz and pebbles. The parcel lies at Domaine Belargus, where it is the only red-grape planting on an estate otherwise given entirely to Chenin Blanc.

VITICULTURE: Organic. Purchased fruit.

WINEMAKING: Organic. Purchased fruit.

AGING: Aged for 8 months in tank (90%) and in used barrels (10%).

BOTTLING: 5-20 mg SO₂ added before bottling.
