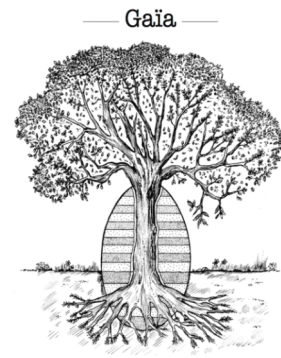


Gaïa, Cuvée Ovoïde

LOCALITY: FRANCE – Loire – Muscadet

APPELLATION: Vin de France

GRAPE VARIETY: Melon de Bourgogne

WINEMAKER: Jérôme Bretaudeau

VINEYARD: 1.5 ha. planted in the 1960s over Gabbro (volcanic) bedrock, sandy, silty topsoil. From multiple mid-slope parcels in Gétigné.

VITICULTURE: Certified organic (Ecocert) and biodynamic (Biodyvin).

WINEMAKING: Grapes are sorted and then lightly pressed, followed by settling under controlled, cool temperatures. Then fermented over ambient yeasts.

AGING: Aged 18-24 months in concrete egg tank.

BOTTLING: Minimal SO2 only added at bottling. Neither fined nor filtered.
