

Bourgogne Aligoté

Comte Armand & Clos des Epeneaux



LOCALITY: FRANCE – Burgundy – Côte de Beaune

APPELLATION: Bourgogne Aligoté

GRAPE VARIETY: Aligoté and Aligoté Doré

WINEMAKER: Paul Zinetti

VINEYARD: Two parcels aggregating 0.5 ha. The first plot, in Volnay, has ten-year-old vines; the second, in Meursault, has ninety-year-old vines.

VITICULTURE: Certified organic (by Ecocert) with biodynamic methods.

WINEMAKING: Pressed with whole cluster. Fermented over ambient yeasts. Coordination with the lunar calendar.

AGING: Aged for 12 months on lees in older barrels (25% new oak). Blended in stainless-steel tank before bottling.

BOTTLING: Fined.
