

Mâcon-Chardonnay, Les Crays

LOCALITY: FRANCE – Burgundy – Mâconnais

APPELLATION: Mâcon-Chardonnay

GRAPE VARIETY: Chardonnay

WINEMAKER: Jean-Philippe and Jean-Guillaume Bret

VINEYARD: 0.5 ha. planted between 1970 and 1990 in *lieu-dit Champvent*. White limestone rocks lay scattered throughout clay soil. West exposition from 280m with 20% gradient. Density of 7500 vines/ha.

VITICULTURE: Certified organic (Ecocert).

WINEMAKING: 100% whole cluster. Fermented over indigenous yeasts in demi-muids. Complete malolactic conversion.

AGING: Aged for 11 months (20% in used 228L *pièces* and 80% in tank).

BOTTLING: Neither fined nor filtered. pH = 3.23.
