LOCALITY: FRANCE – Burgundy – Côte de Nuits

APELLATION: Échezeaux Grand Cru

GRAPE VARIETY: Pinot Noir

WINEMAKER: Charles Lachaux

VINEYARD: 0.9 ha. planted in the 1930s; *lieu-dit Les Rouges du Bas* in Flagey-Echézeaux. Oxidized iron-rich soil. Facing east.

VITICULTURE: Regenerative agriculture, biodynamic methods and organic (in official conversion). Gobelet pruning, complete cessation of trimming and high trellising.

WINEMAKING: 100% whole cluster. Fermented over native yeasts.

AGING: Aged for 14 months in used barrels (30% new). Blended and aged for 2 additional months in tank.
