LOCALITY: FRANCE – Burgundy – Côte de Beaune

APPELLATION: Bourgogne Aligoté

GRAPE VARIETY: Aligoté

WINEMAKER: Tomoko Kuriyama and Guillaume Bott

VINEYARD: Planted in the 1980s. On a steep slope above *Les Monts de Fussey* and just below *Mainbey*.

VITICULTURE: Organic farming (not certified) with biodynamic methods.

WINEMAKING: Crushed. Long press cycle (6 hours). Fermented over ambient yeasts using *pied de cuve*.

AGING: Aged for 12 months in 228L and 600L barrels.

BOTTLING: No fining. Occasional light filtration. Minimal SO2 addition, if necessary, before bottling.
