

Nuits-Saint-Georges, La Petite Charmotte

LOCALITY: FRANCE – Burgundy – Côte de Nuits

APPELLATION: Nuits-Saint-Georges

GRAPE VARIETY: Pinot Noir

WINEMAKER: Charles Lachaux

VINEYARD: Planted in the 1960s. *Lieu-dit La Petite Charmotte* is situated on the northern side of Nuits-Saint-Georges, toward Vosne-Romanée, on the eastern border with the Premiers Crus, south of *Aux Allots* and east of *Aux Bousselets*. The soil is a mixture of clay with a preponderance of limestone.

VITICULTURE: Organic and biodynamic (not certified).

WINEMAKING: 100% whole cluster. Macerated for 10 days with 2 punch-downs total. Fermented over indigenous yeasts in stainless-steel tank.

AGING: Aged for 12 months in used barrels (50%) and ceramic tank (50%).

BOTTLING: Neither fined nor filtered. No added sulfur.
