

Vosne-Romanée, Les Hautes Maizières

LOCALITY: FRANCE – Burgundy – Côte de Nuits

APPELLATION: Vosne-Romanée, *Les Hautes Maizières*

GRAPE VARIETY: Pinot Noir

WINEMAKER: Charles Lachaux

VINEYARD: 0.6 ha. planted in the 1950s; *lieu-dit Les Hautes Maizières* in Vosne-Romanée. Iron-rich and clay-limestone soil. Next to the southern wall of the Clos de Vougeot.

VITICULTURE: Regenerative agriculture, biodynamic methods and organic (in official conversion). Gobelet pruning, complete cessation of trimming and high trellising.

WINEMAKING: 60% whole cluster. Fermented over native yeasts.

AGING: Aged for 14 months in used barrels (10% new). Blended and aged for 2 additional months in tank.
