

Bourgogne Pinot Noir

LOCALITY: FRANCE – Burgundy

APPELLATION: Bourgogne

GRAPE VARIETY: 100% Pinot Noir

WINEMAKER: Frédéric Lafarge

VINEYARD: Southeast-facing single parcel 1.2 ha. *lieu-dit Petit Pré*, planted 1966-1977 over clay-limestone soil. Situated halfway between the village of Volnay and the RN74, abutting the village classification boundary, Russell Hone describes the parcel as a “baby Volnay”.

VITICULTURE: Certified organic (Ecocert) and biodynamic (Demeter).

WINEMAKING: De-stemmed and macerated for two weeks, followed by fermentation over indigenous yeasts.

AGING: Aged for 18 months in older barrels.

BOTTLING: Neither fined nor filtered.
