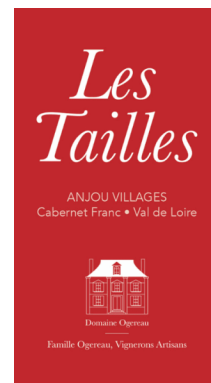


Anjou Rouge, Les Tailles

OGEREAU



LOCALITY: FRANCE – Loire – Anjou

APPELLATION: Anjou

GRAPE VARIETY: Cabernet Sauvignon

WINEMAKER: Vincent and Emmanuel Ogereau

VINEYARD: 1.3 ha. with oldest vines planted in the 1950s and the youngest in the 1980s. Located in the village of Saint-Lambert-du-Lattay on the banks of the *Hyrôme*, a small tributary of the Layon. Briovarian sandstone schist soils, rich in quartz.

VITICULTURE: Organic (certified Ecocert) and biodynamic conversion (Biodyvin). Guyot-Poussard pruning.

WINEMAKING: 80% de-stemmed. Maceration for 11 days and gentle infusion. Complete malolactic fermentation.

AGING: Aged for 10 months in underground tile-lined tanks and terracotta amphora.

BOTTLING: Light earth filtration.
