LOCALITY: FRANCE – Loire – Sancerre

APPELLATION: Sancerre

GRAPE VARIETY: Pinot Noir

WINEMAKER: Florent and Clément Pinard

VINEYARD: On average 50-year-old vines over clay-limestone soil based on limestone. Parcel located in Bué. 250-270m elevation. Density of 7000 vines/ha.

VITICULTURE: Organic and biodynamic (certification in progress). Guyot-Poussard pruning. Yield 35 hL.

WINEMAKING: Fermented over indigenous yeasts.

AGING: Aged for 17 to 20 months in barrels.

BOTTLING: Neither fined nor filtered.
