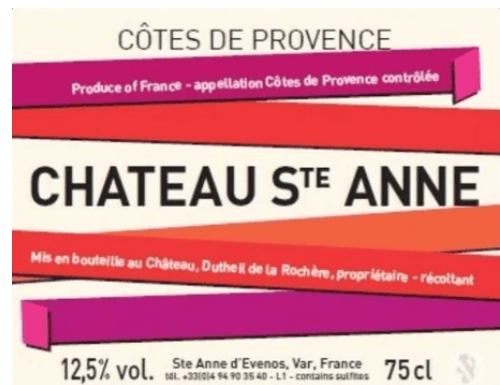


Côte de Provence Rosé

Château SAINTE-ANNE



LOCALITY: FRANCE – Provence – Bandol

APPELLATION: Côte de Provence

GRAPE VARIETY: 25% Mourvèdre, 25% Grenache, 25% Cinsault and 25% Carignan

WINEMAKER: Jean-Baptiste Dutheil

VINEYARD: 35-85 years old vines planted on admixture of limestone, white sand and silica. Hillside with a southeastern exposition.

VITICULTURE: Certified organic (AB/ Ecofeuille). Gobelet pruning. Yield 27 hl/ha.

WINEMAKING: Directly pressed and macerated for one day. Then spontaneous fermentation in stainless-steel tank over indigenous yeasts.

AGING: Aged in *foudres* tank for 18 to 24 months.

BOTTLING: Neither fined nor filtered.
