

Bourgogne Pinot Noir

LIGNIER-MICHELOT

LOCALITY: FRANCE – Burgundy

APPELLATION: Bourgogne

GRAPE VARIETY: Pinot Noir

WINEMAKER: Virgile Lignier

VINEYARD: 1.1 ha. planted in the 1960s over deep clay soils.

VITICULTURE: Organic (not certified). Farmed according to the lunar calendar. Guyot and cordon training; high trellising.

WINEMAKING: 20-25% whole cluster. Cold maceration and fermented over indigenous yeasts.

AGING: Aged for 12 months in barrels (20-30% new). Then blended and aged for 4 additional months in stainless steel tank.

BOTTLING: No fining, minimal filtration.
