

Chambolle-Musigny, Vieilles Vignes

LIGNIER-MICHELOT



LOCALITY: FRANCE – Burgundy – Côte de Nuits

APPELLATION: Chambolle-Musigny

GRAPE VARIETY: Pinot Noir

WINEMAKER: Virgile Lignier

VINEYARD: 1.5 ha. planted in the 1955 and 1957. From 2 parcels: *Les Drazey* (limestone soils) and *Les Gamaires* (deep clays soils).

VITICULTURE: Organic (not certified). Farmed according to the lunar calendar. Guyot and cordon training; high trellising.

WINEMAKING: 50% whole cluster. Short cold maceration. Then fermented over indigenous yeasts.

AGING: Aged for 12 months in barrels (20% new). Then blended and aged for 4 additional months in stainless steel tank.

BOTTLING: No fining, minimal filtration.
